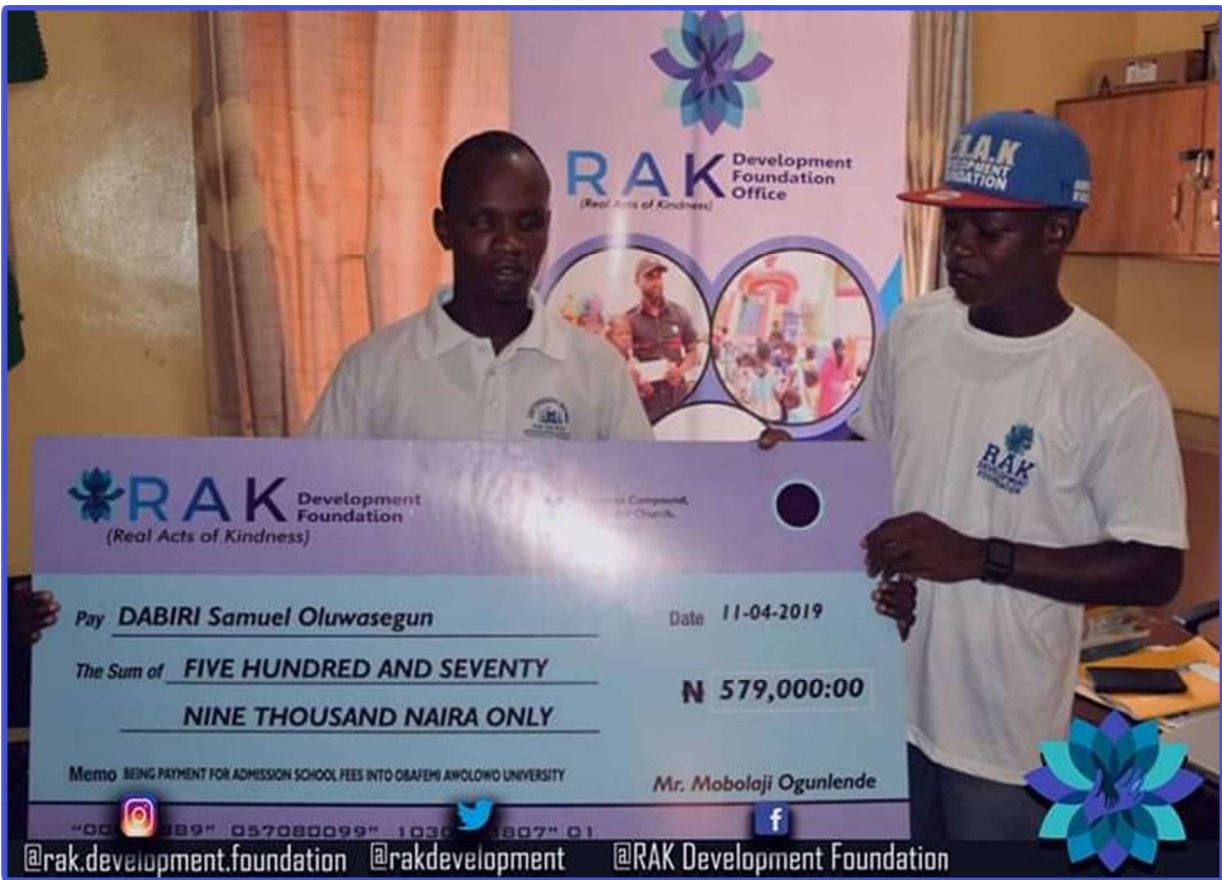
Ileya 2019 Badagry Carnival

Rak Development Foundation through our workshop continuously trains on Soap making, insecticides and Knitting. At the end of the training we empower all participants with start-up kits.

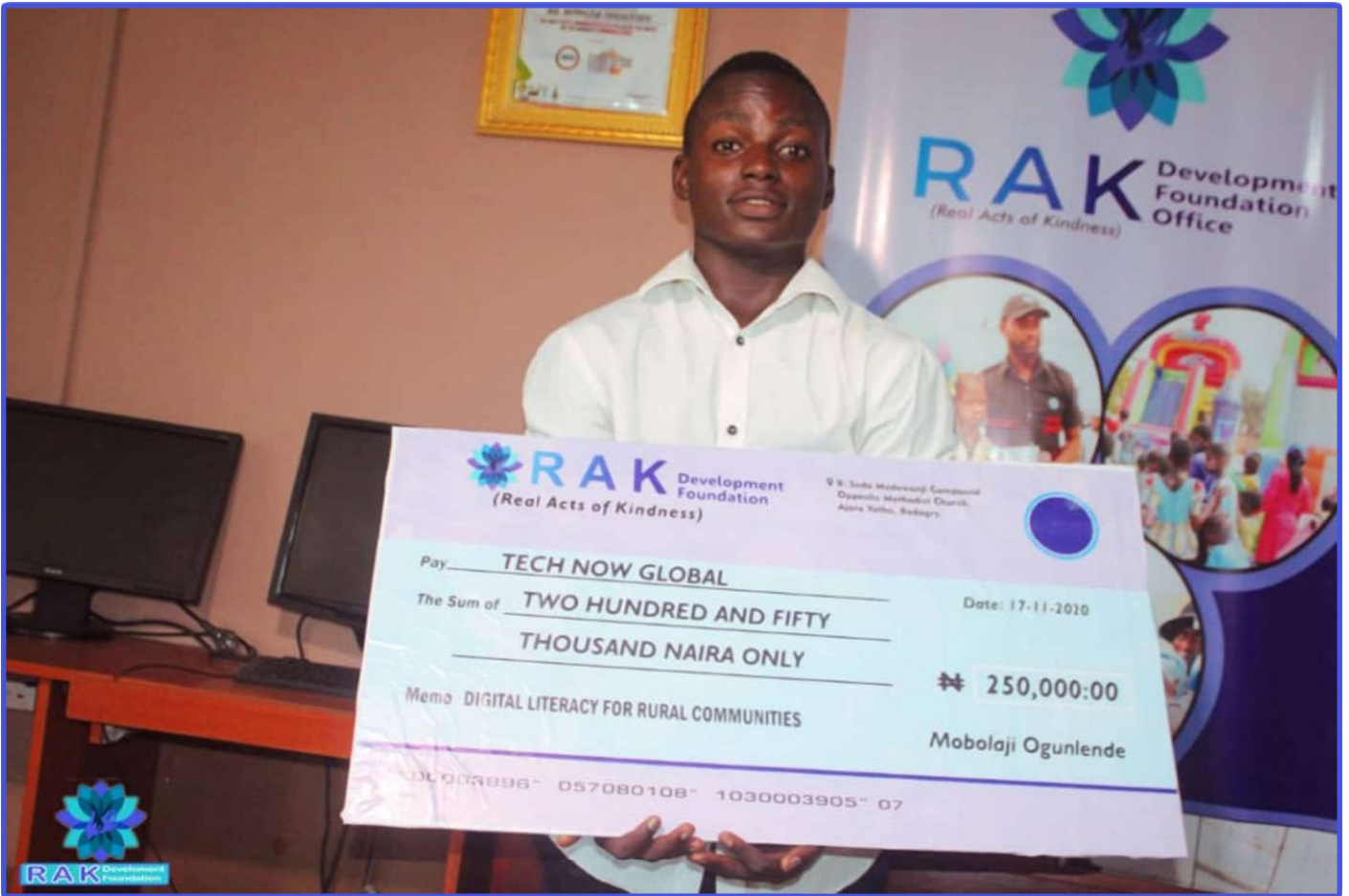

Rak Development Foundation donated sets of sewing machines to Association of Tailors, Badagry Chapter to support their entrepreneurship goals.



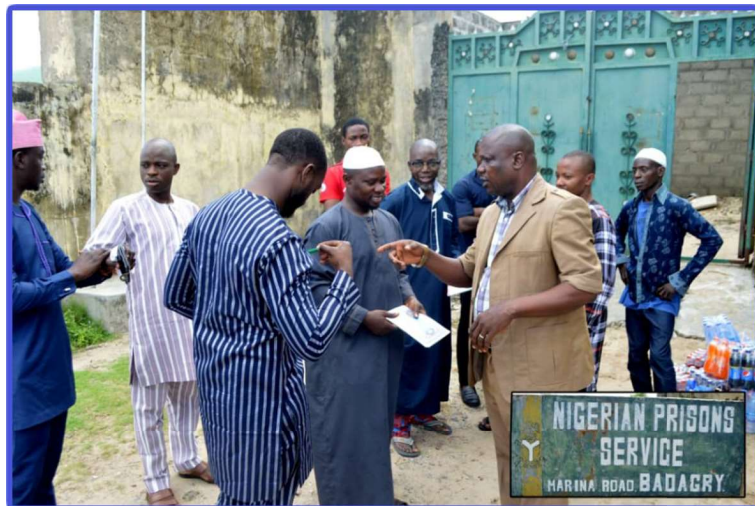
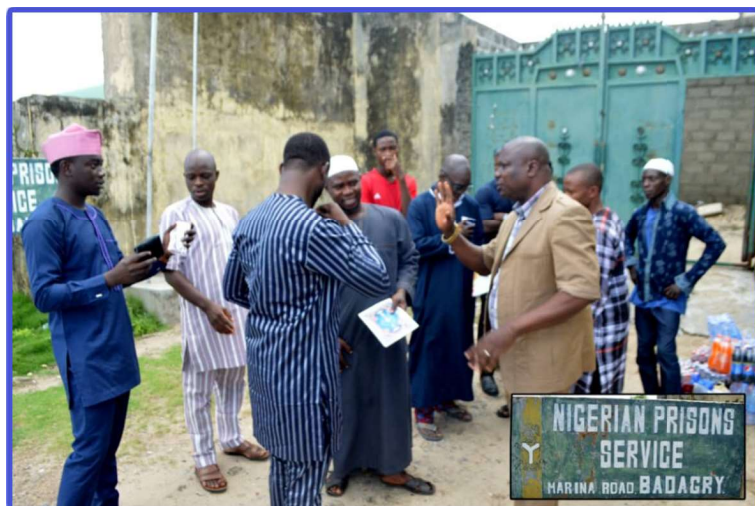
Donation of Furnitures to Iworo Ajido Senior and Junior Model College

RAK Collaborates With Dejabys Bakery To Share Palliatives

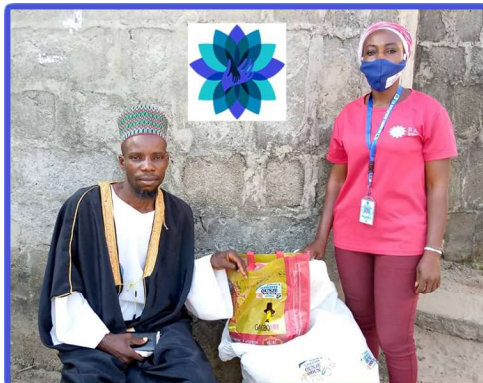

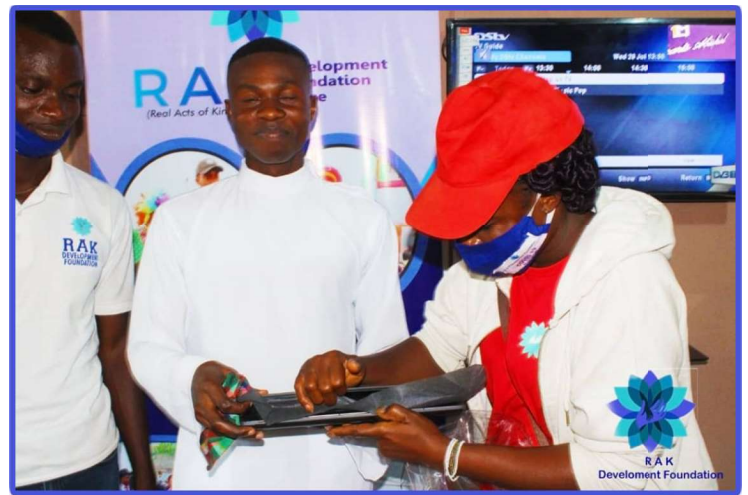
Ounje Odun (Post Ramadan)

Result - Clean water flowing in a community that has struggled to have clean water. Prevention of water borne diseases that come from unclean water. Achieving SDG 6.



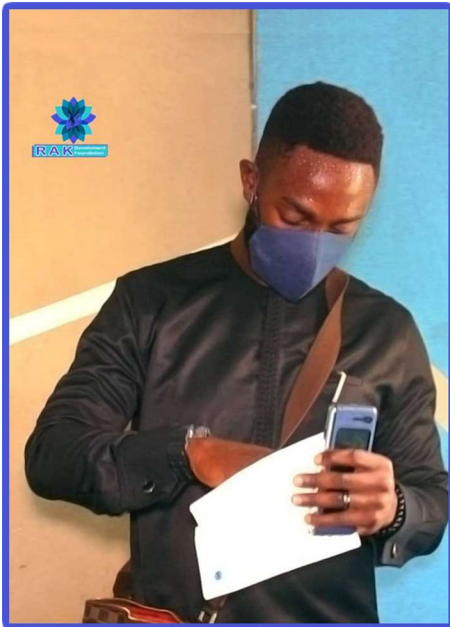
Baby Joseph

With a baby on the way, the pandemic hit, mum who was a school teacher stopped work and dad was laid off due to pressure on various companies during the period.

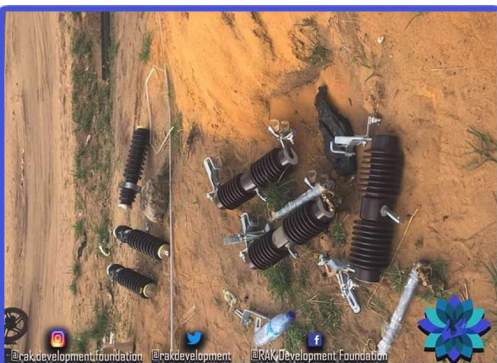
The news got to the pioneer and a decision was made to support them. The funds from TA-35D came in very handy.

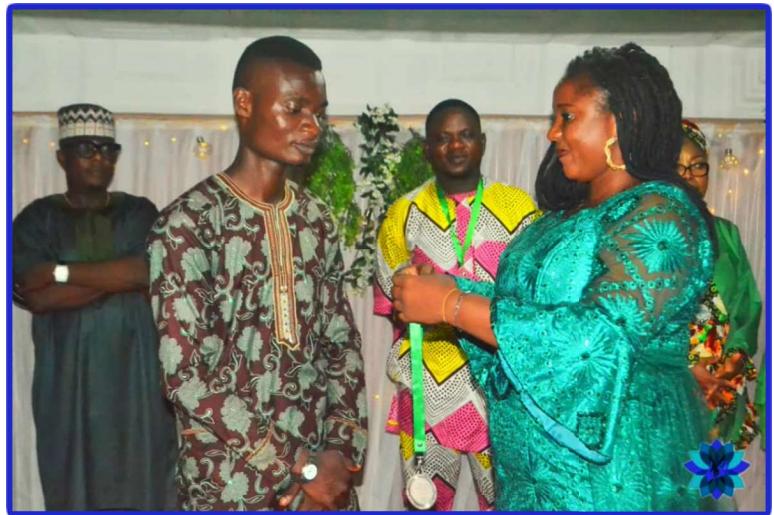


This award was based on an extensive passionate of the pioneer's leadership dexterity, patriotic zeal to Nation building and passionate commitment to youth and women empowerment.
