We are proud to support her and hope to see her make more strides. We also hope to see her book - Beyond the Pressure - impact every generation."

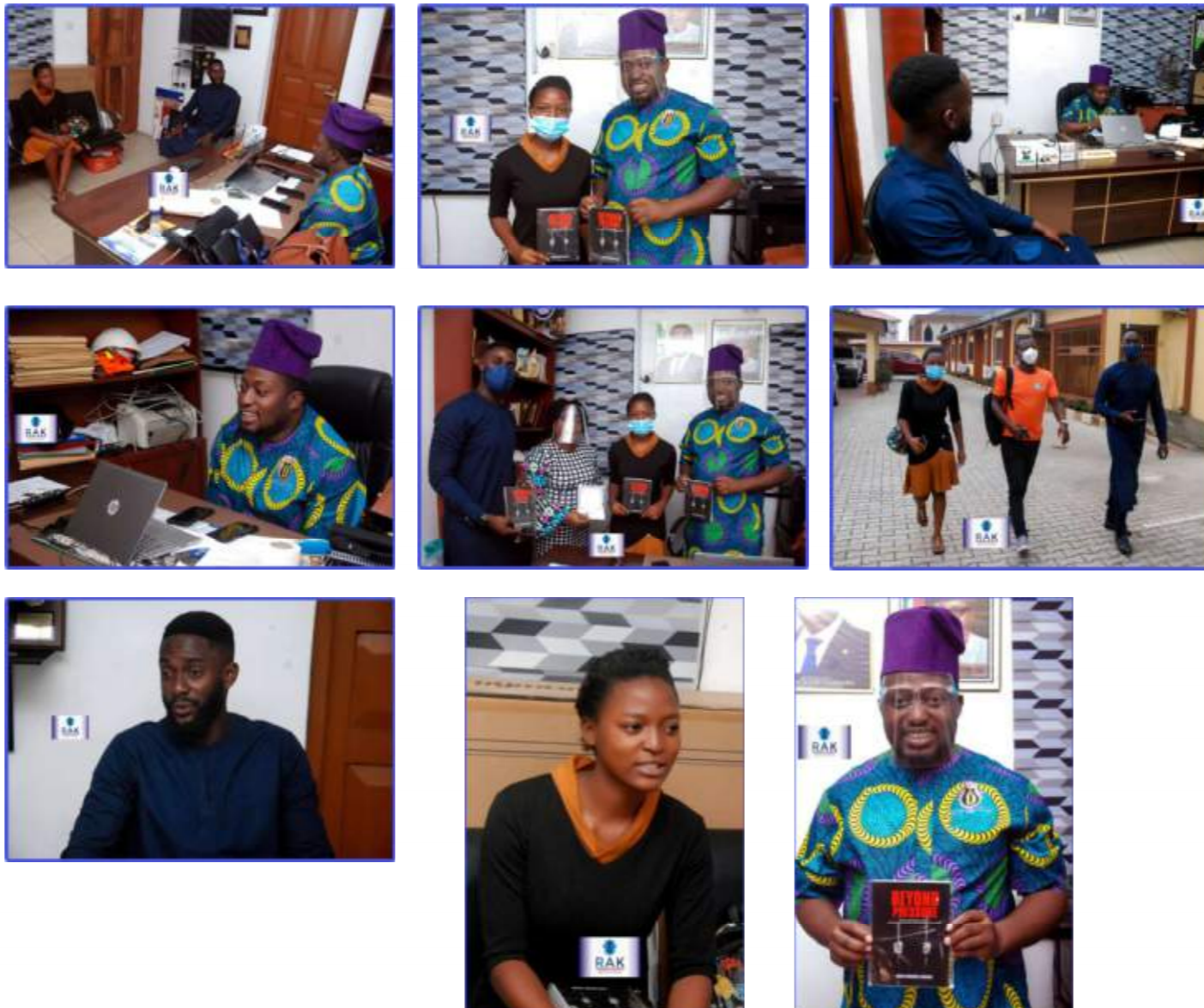


